## Participation of Caribbean Countries in the Third Evaluation Round of the MEM

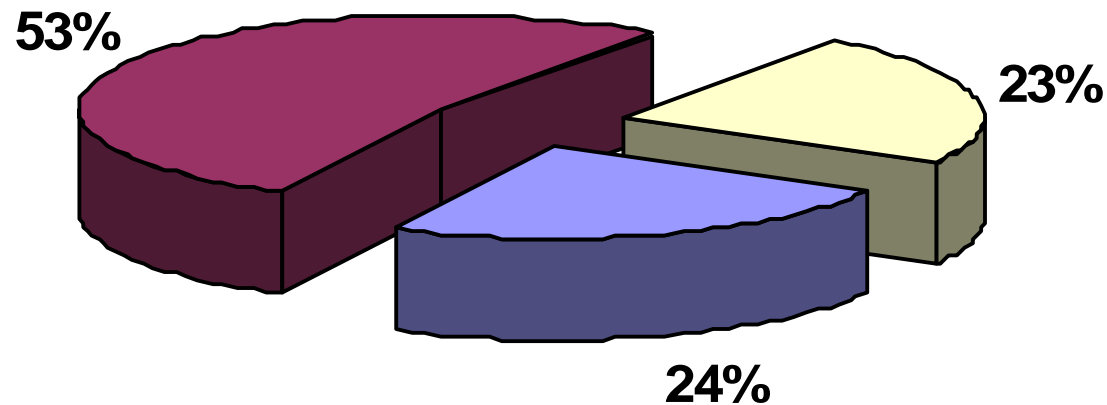

# Situation of the Recommendations Assigned to the Caribbean in the Third Evaluation Round

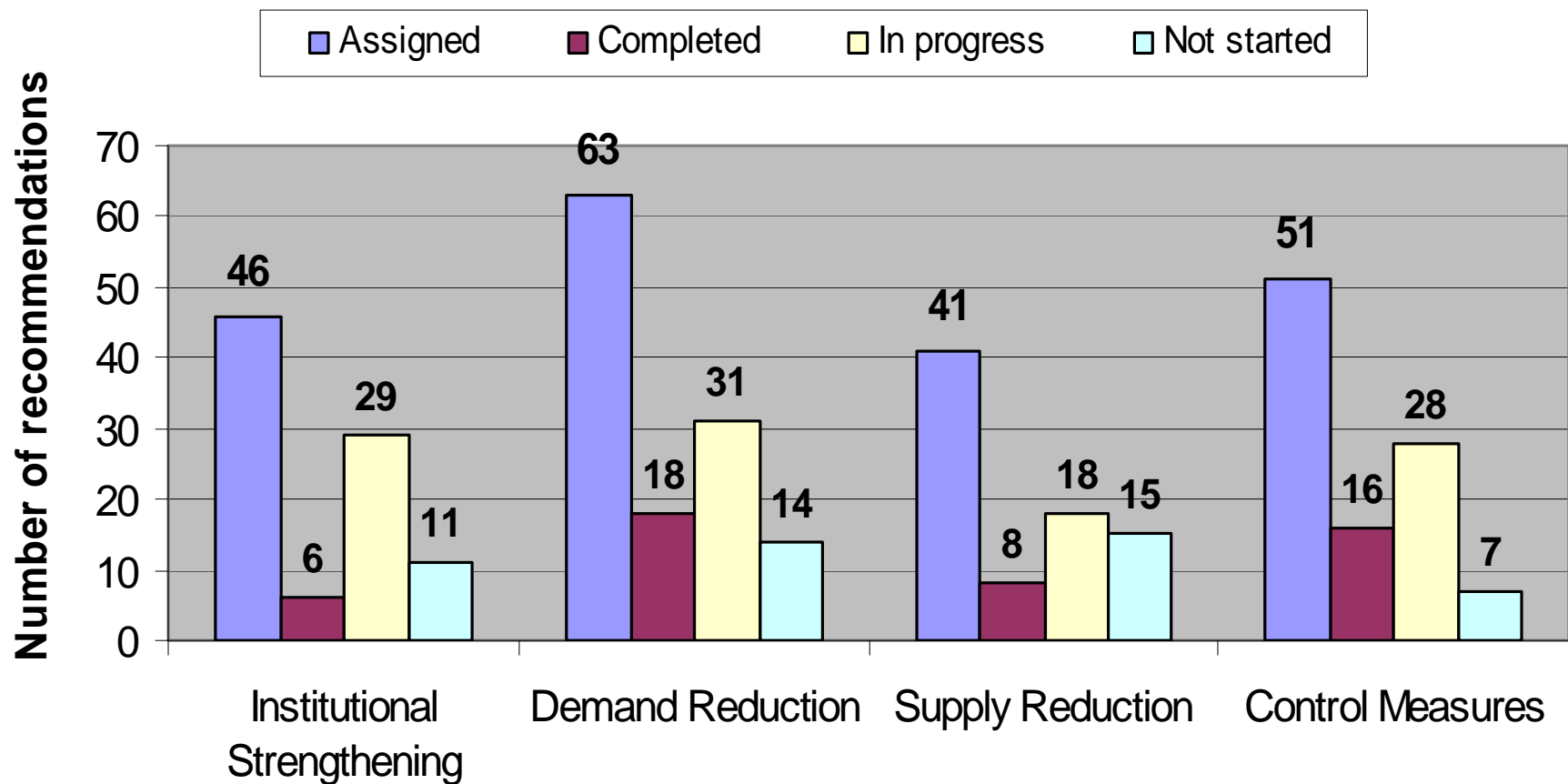

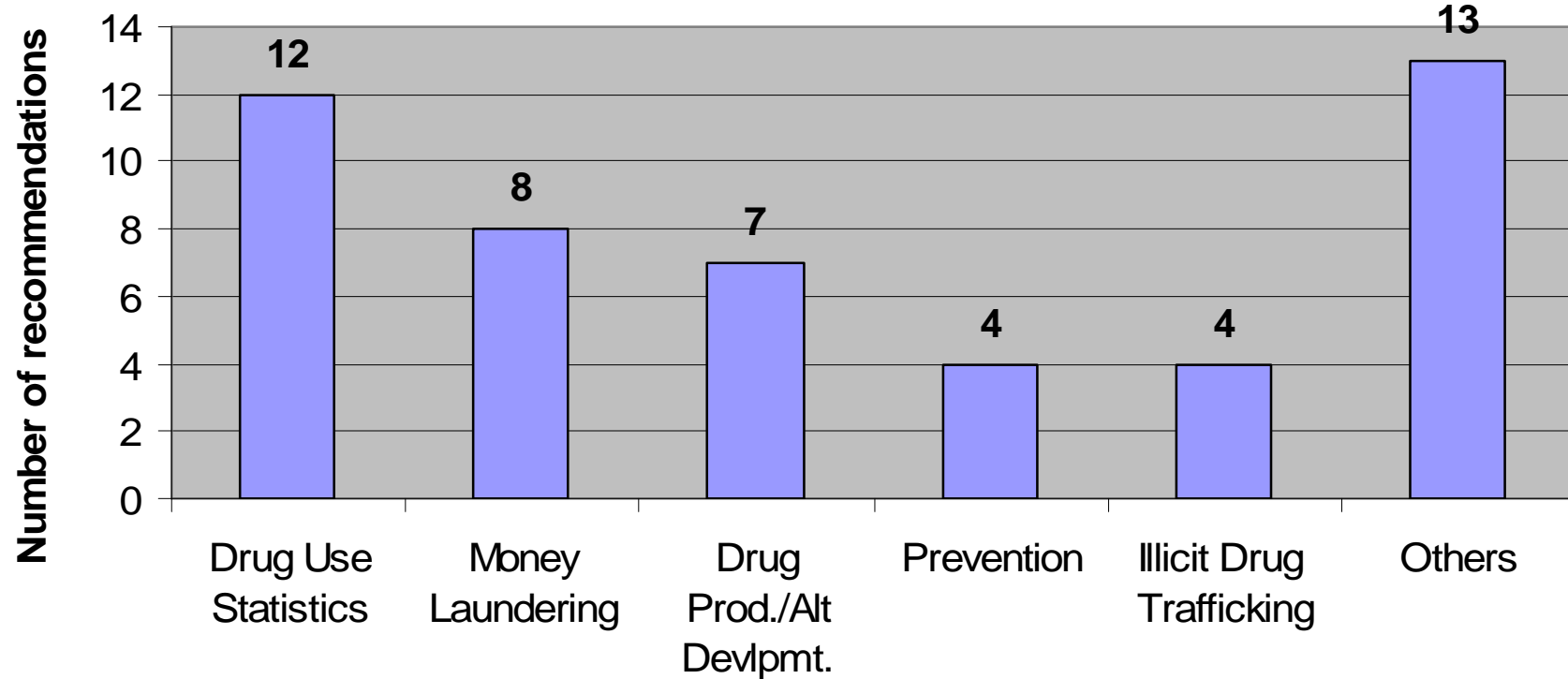

# Number of Recommendations Assigned, Completed, in Progress and Not Started in the Caribbean, by Thematic Area



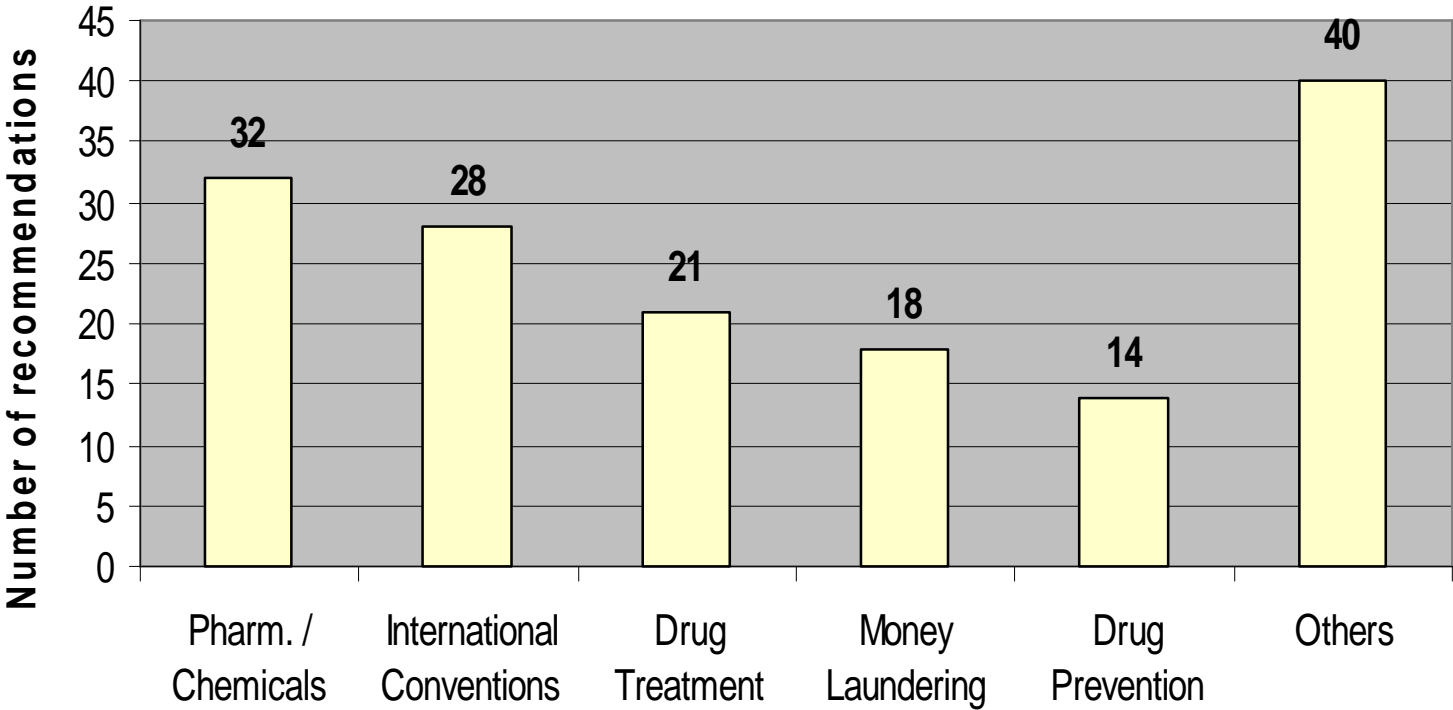
# Highest Number of Recommendations Completed in the Caribbean, by Subject
